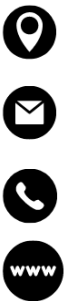

Forest School

James Dixon Forest School is an opportunity for your child to experience nature and outdoor learning in a safe, secure and hands-on way. Children learn best from first hand experiences. Exploring and learning using a range of activities both designed by the leader and instigated by the children themselves is what Forest School is all about, allowing them to build a sense of independence, high self-esteem and teamwork.

This Autumn Term Forest School for the following years and days are as follows:

Year 1: Mondays (come to school in Active Wear/PE kit)

Reception: Tuesdays (come to school in Forest School clothes and bring Active Wear/PE kit in a bag)

Year 3 (Resilient): Thursdays - Finishing 17/10/24 (come to school in Active Wear/PE kit)

Year 3 (Reflective): Fridays - Starting 8/11/24 (come to school in Active Wear/PE kit)

Health and safety considerations are always of paramount importance, we require each child to have a medical form filled out to participate. The school is supplying waterproof clothing for all children but we would like your child to have their own pair of wellie boots for sizing and hygiene reasons.
