I am a monkey who taught myself to read.

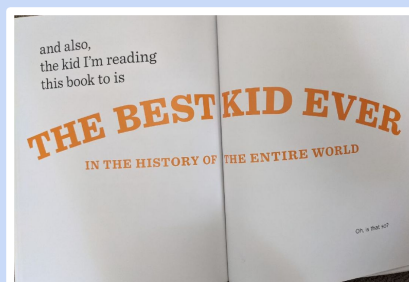
Hey! I'm not a monkey!

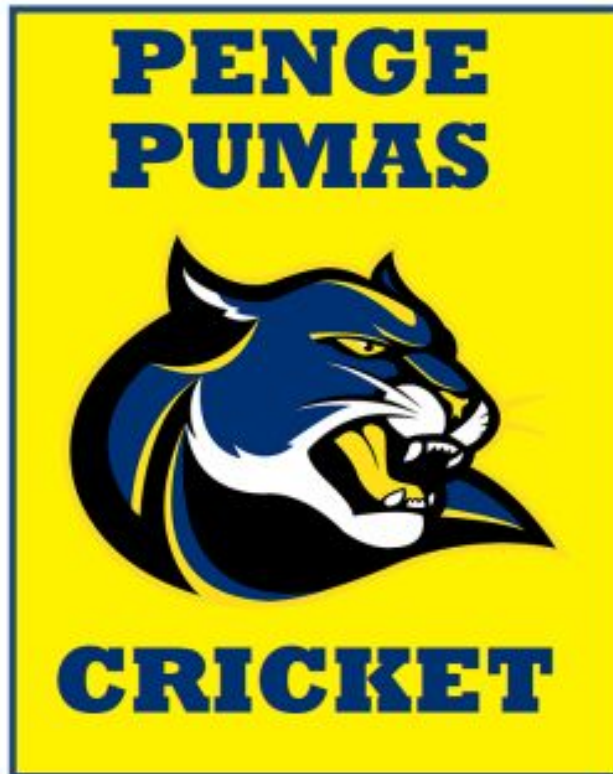

What is a Jolly Jar?
