
As **active learners**, we will continue to learn new GPCs during Phonics sessions and will use the sounds we have learnt when reading and writing. In Maths, we will be learning all about the numbers 1 to 5, focusing on comparison, subitising, counting, cardinality and ordinality. We will also be exploring 2D shapes and daily routines of day and night.

As **creative explorers**, we will be continuing our singing lessons with Mr. Dowling from BYMT and learning the songs for our Christmas performance.









Global Citizens

Our **Jigsaw** theme for this term will be **Celebrating Difference**. We will be learning to talk about what we are good at and thinking about ways in which we are special. Furthermore, we will focus on how to make friends and resolve conflicts with confidence.

As **global citizens**, we will be learning about Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day and the Christian festival of Christmas and the Jewish festival of Hannukah.
