As writers we will be continuing to follow Letters and Sounds by Little Wandle. We will also be learning to add suffixes to words such as ed, es, s and ing.

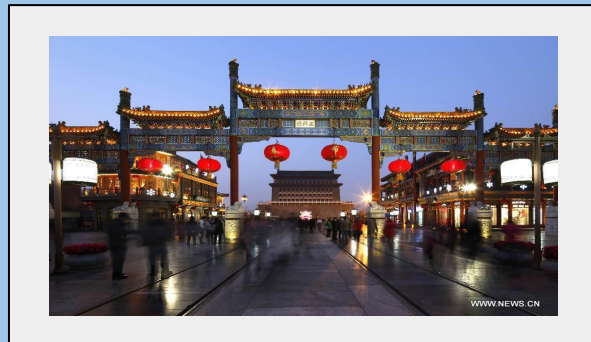
As mathematicians we be exploring place value to 50 and beyond. We will be using this knowledge to add and subtract one digit and 2 digit numbers. We will begin to use arrays to support counting in steps of 2's, 5's and 10's. As we develop our skills and confidence, we will be learning to explain the methodology behind our answers when solving problems.

As Geographers we will be exploring the United Kingdom and looking at what the Union Jack flag represents.

In art, we will be studying architecture and learning about what goes into designing a building. We will then use this knowledge to make a replica of a famous building at the end of the term.

As musicians we will listening to and reflecting on traditional and modern Chinese music. We will be using instruments to create short compositions based around different animals.

As Scientists we will learn about the different animal groups including humans and describe and compare their diets using the vocabulary - carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.



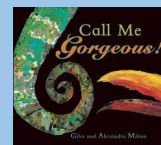
Global Citizens
