Our Creative Curriculum

As **confident individuals**, we will be using our classroom, the resources and activities with increasing independence. We will be selecting our own resources and talking about our choices and the reasons for them. We will be further developing our abilities to resolve conflicts with others and discussing our individual differences and preferences.

As **successful learners**, we will we will look at time, focusing on the days of the week and ordering and sequencing of time. We will build on our number knowledge, with a look at 9 and 10, including bonds to ten and doubles to ten. We will also learn about 3-D shapes. We will be continuing our Little Wandle sessions and will use our knowledge of segmenting and blending to help us to write independently. We will also be engaging in 'Talk for Writing' to help us develop story maps and create our own stories.

As **active learners**, we will be continuing our weekly P.E sessions which will be focused around Gymnastics. We will work on the physical skills of shapes, balances, jumps, rocking, rolling and travel and social skills of working safely, collaborating, sharing and taking turns.

As **creative explorers**, we will enjoy creating a range of dinosaur themed artwork using different techniques and materials such as paint, collage and clay. We will enjoy modelling our own dinosaurs as well as using natural materials to build skeletons.



Global Citizens

Our **Jigsaw** theme for this term will be **Relationships**. We will be learning all about what makes a good friend and how to maintain respectful relationships.

As part of our outdoor learning, we will be looking closely at the environment around us and talking about how to take care of nature and the creatures and plants that live in our world.

We will continue to use our recycling bins and use recyclable materials.

We will be enjoying a local trip to Crystal Palace Park to look at and draw the dinosaurs. We will also be focusing on how to stay safe in a group and when crossing the roads.
