Our Creative Curriculum

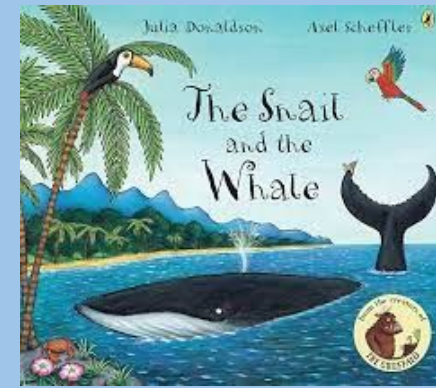
As **writers** we will recap writing simple sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will also practice our letter formation using the precursive formation. Children will also be introduced to adjectives this term and will be encouraged to use them when writing a sentence.

As **Mathematicians** we will continue to count in steps of 2's, 5's and 10's. We will learn how to represent a number in different ways, use the part whole model and focus on addition and subtraction.

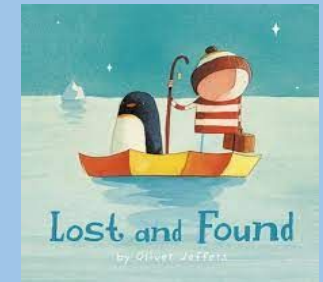
As **Geographers** we will be focusing on Spatial Sense, looking at aerial views, key features of a map and how to use compass points to help us navigate.

As **Scientists** we will observe the change in weather as we head into Autumn and consider what this means for us and animals.
