

- ★ Beware of predators using third-party chat apps. Even with parental controls turned on and chat messaging turned off, predators have found a way to communicate with children while they play Roblox.
- ★ Watch out for sexualized avatars.
- ★ Be cautious with Roblox YouTube videos.
- ★ Look out for bypassed audios.

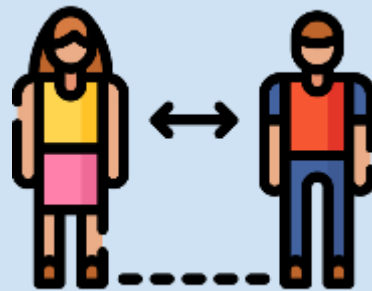


Social Distancing

Born in Jamaica Sterling moved to London at the age of five. Sterling was born in Kingston, Jamaica, and spent his early years there.

His mother, Nadine Clarke, was a competitive athlete in the Jamaican national athletics team; Sterling credits her for his unique running style. His father was murdered in Jamaica when Sterling was two years old. At the age of five, he emigrated to Neasden, London with his mother, and attended Copland School in Wembley, North West London.
