As Scientists we will be looking at how the weather changes across each season. We will have a particular focus on Autumn and Winter and the differences between the two seasons.



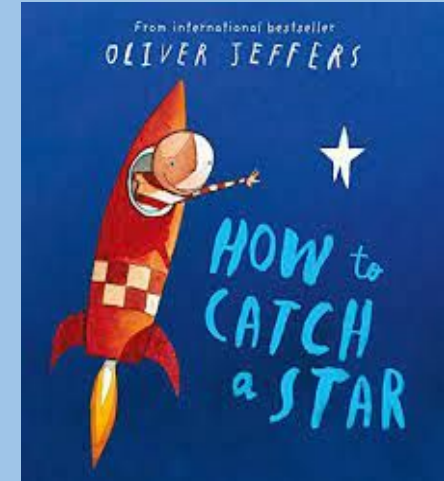
Global Citizens
