Our Creative Curriculum

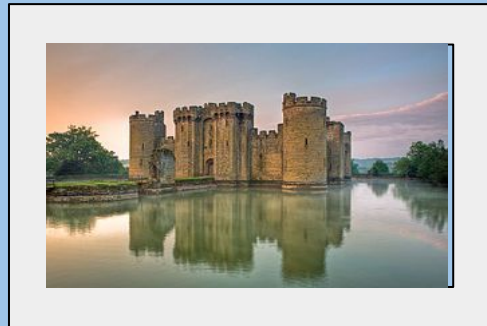
As writers we will continue to focus on learning new sounds and consolidating the ones we already know. We will also learn how to add labels to our pictures of castles and dragons.

As Scientists we will be exploring our senses. We will also start our new topic learning all about plants.



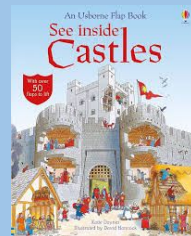
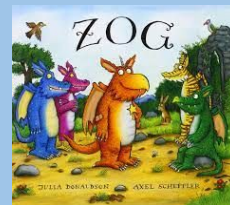
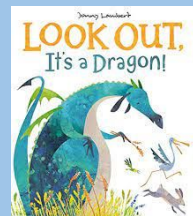
Global Citizens
