Our Creative Curriculum

As writers we will introduce alien words (fake words) in preparation for the Phonics Screening in June. Phonics will continue everyday. In English, we will focus on writing a description of a scene and learn how to write a book/film review.

As mathematicians we will learn the concept of multiplication and how to draw arrays to help us work out the answer. We will then review doubling and end the term with fractions, where children learn to find half and quarter of a number and shape.

As Geographers we will learn about the seven continents and five oceans of the world.

As artists we will be looking at paintings of children, in particular paintings by Hogarth, Cassatt and Bruegel the Elder. Children will use photographs of themselves to explore poses which they use at the end of the unit to reinvent portraits in a modern way, based on David Hockney.

As Scientists we will be learning about plants. Children will



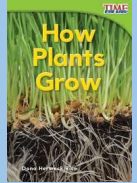
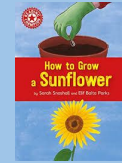
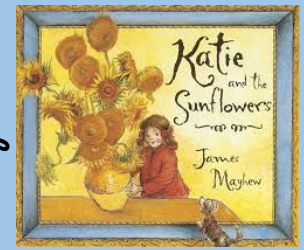
Global Citizens
