

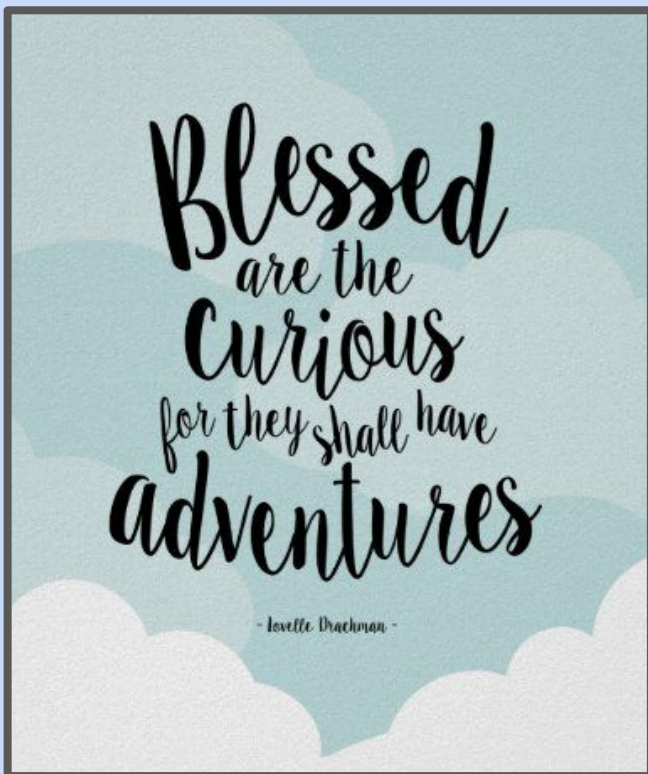


Curious Class Newsletter

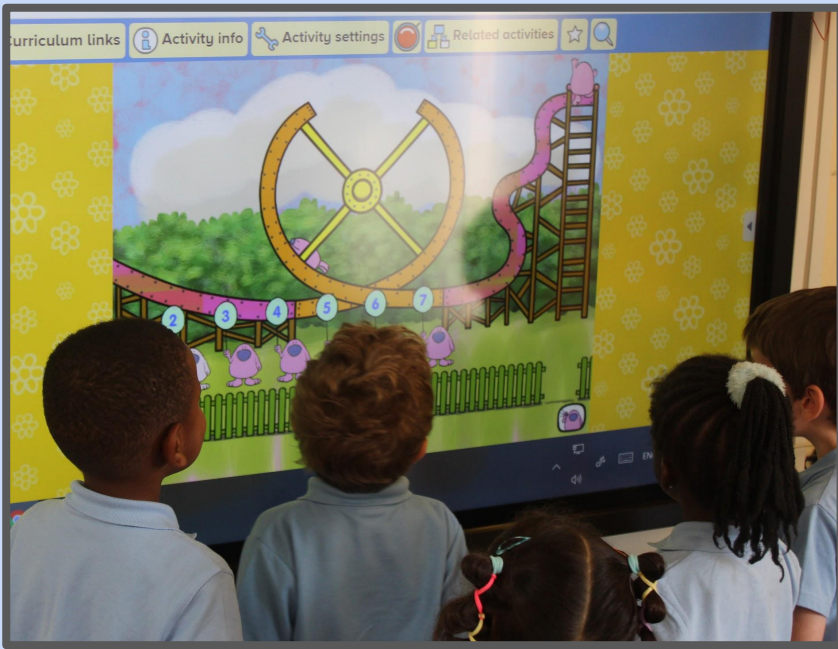
Friday 10th September

Maths in Reception

We use Numberblocks, as part of the White Rose Maths scheme. Children use a mastery approach to develop problem solving skills and mathematical structures and patterns, working within small numbers. The chance to make mistakes also works towards the development of growth mindset.
