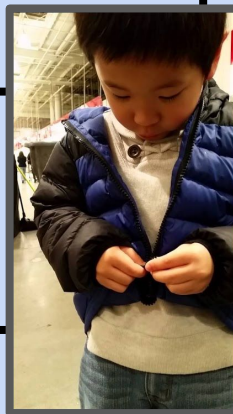
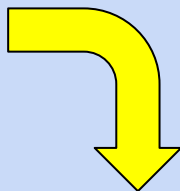
Home-learning in Reception -

We spent a while looking up at the clouds to see if we could see any shapes! We also spotted the moon and questioned why we could see it in the day!

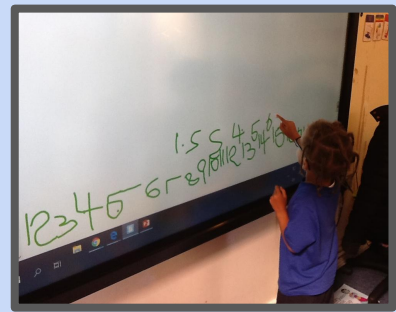
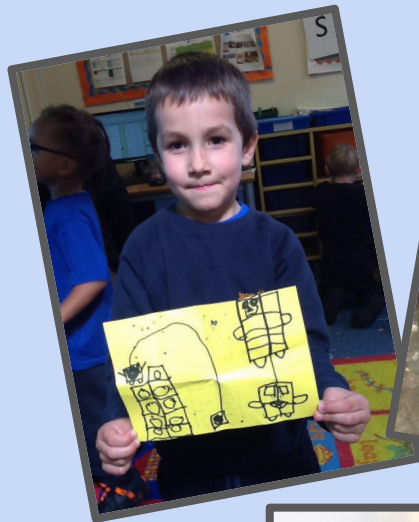


Some of us went on a leaf journey. We looked out for fallen leaves and added them to our stick if we like them. We enjoyed finding two of the same!
