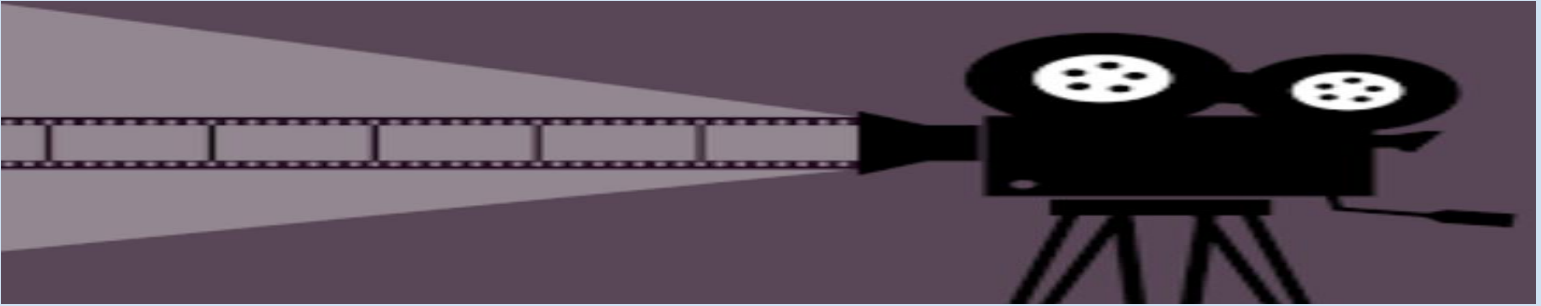
Pre-School **Space Day**



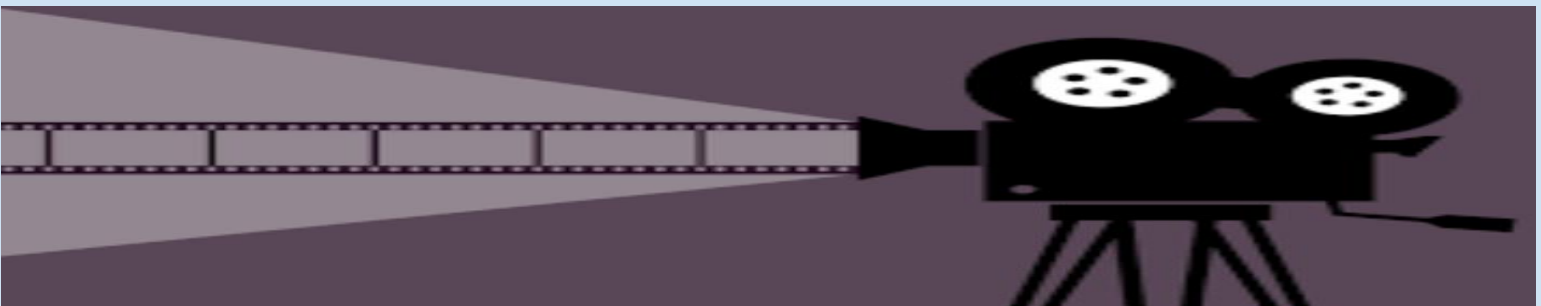
