What's happening this term?



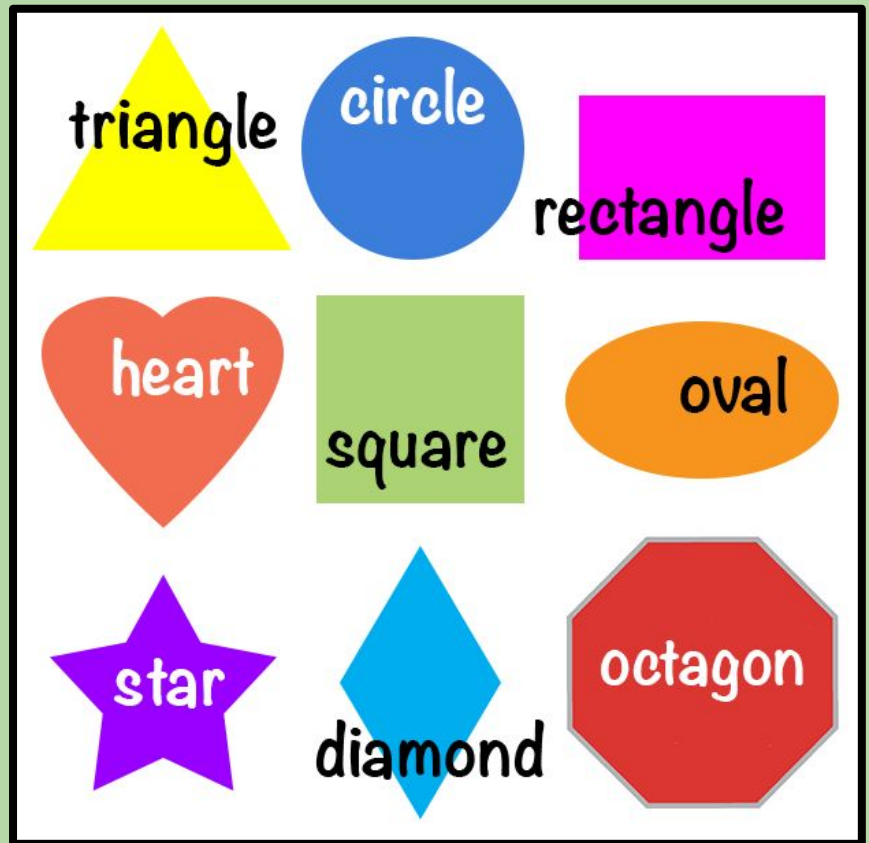
The Dinosaurs have come to Curious Class!
