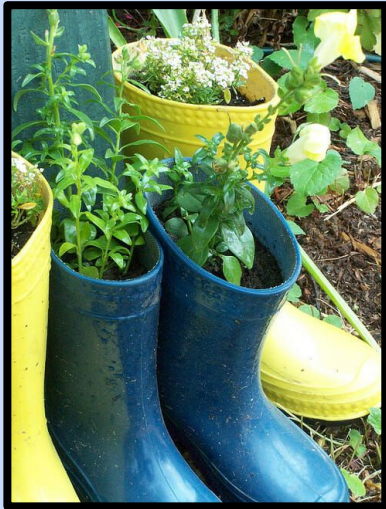

Curious class enjoyed their dance workshop this week. We learned a traditional dance and used fans to help express ourselves.



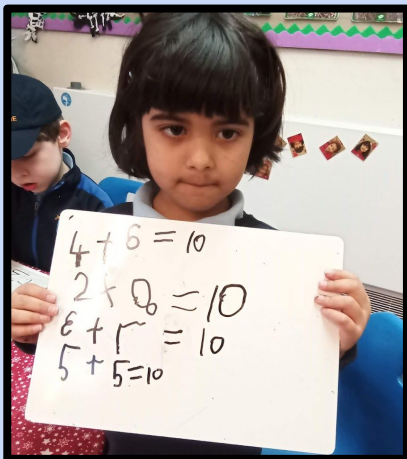
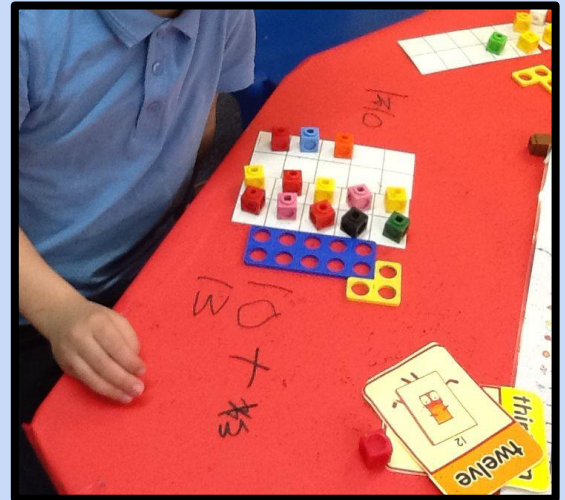
We have learned a lot about Chinese New Year and talked about our own special days that we celebrate at home.



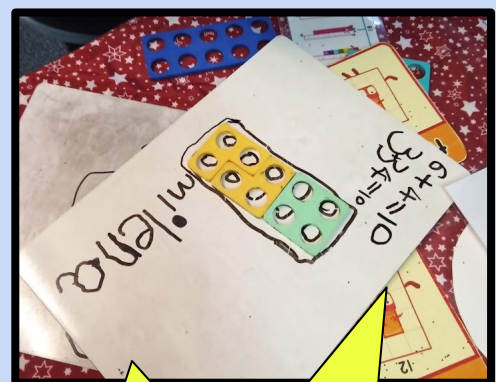
Maths in Reception

We have been developing our physical skills by climbing and building.

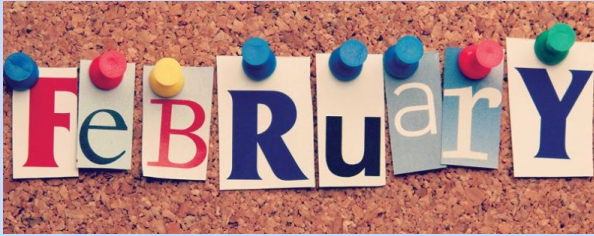


We have been sharing our ideas about what we want to learn about next half term.
