As **active learners** we will listen to different stories and poems that explore minibeasts. We will explore healthy eating through the story *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*. We will begin to hear initial letter sounds in words through songs and games. We will practice writing our names and make a class book about minibeasts. We will continue to explore numbers from 0-10.

As **creative explorers** we will look after the caterpillars and learn about the butterfly life cycle. We will make symmetrical butterflies using different techniques. We will continue to talk about our play describing why things

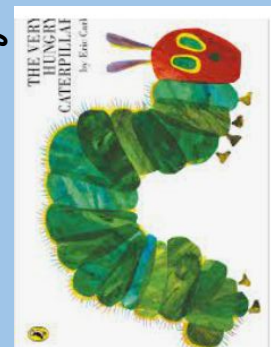


Global Citizens
