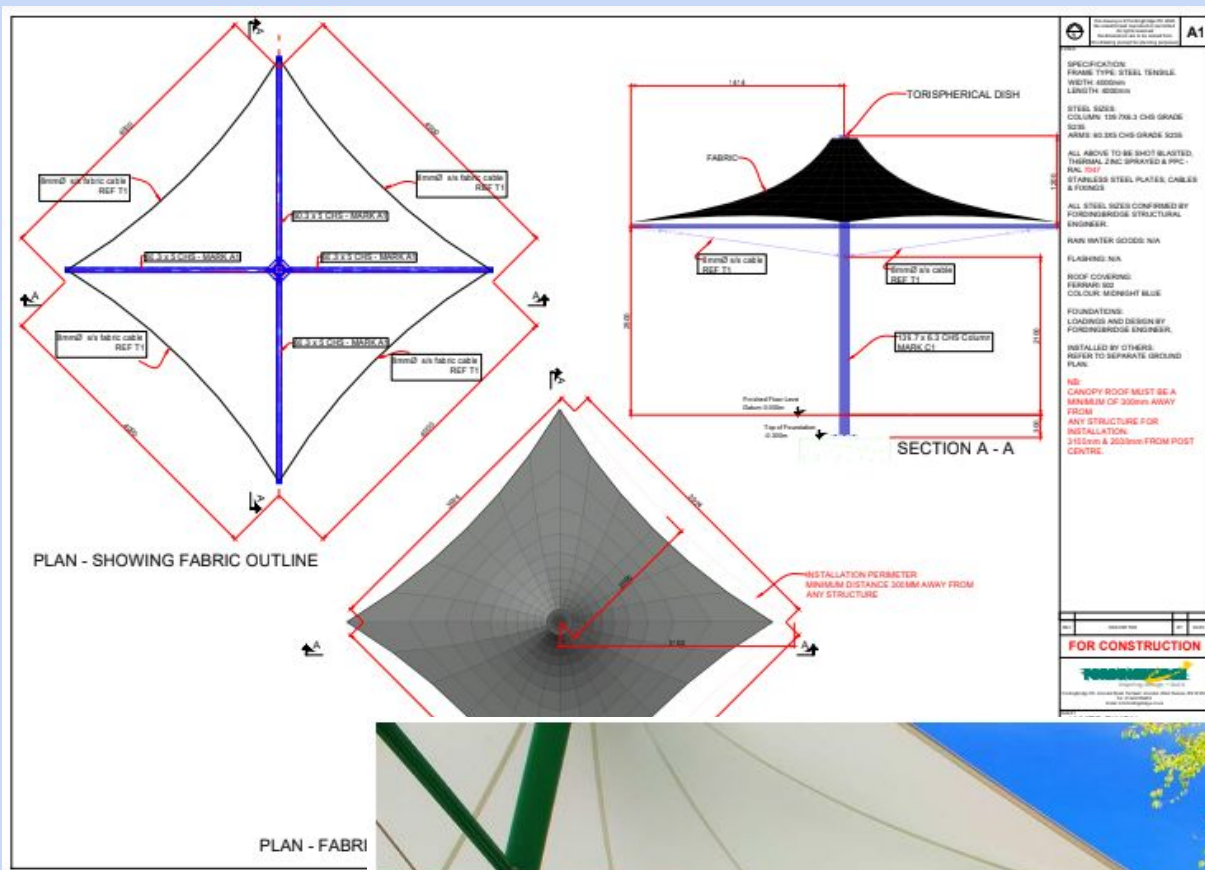

Communicating online
