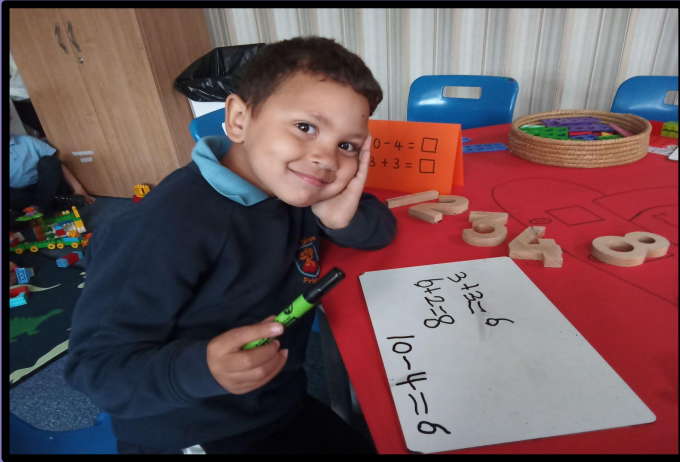
Friday 20th May
