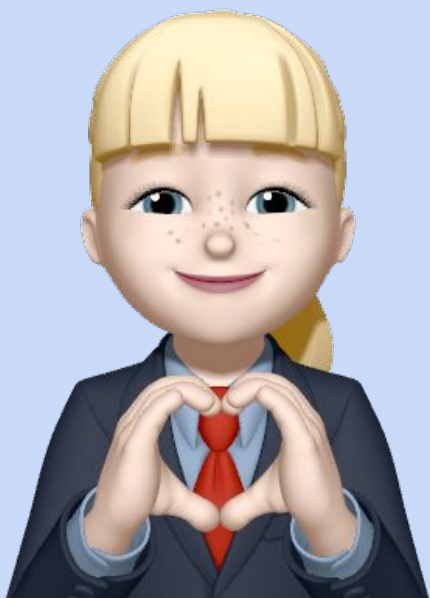

# Marie Van Brittan Brown



Marie Van Brittan Brown was born on October 30th 1922 and is famous for having invented a video home security system now more commonly known as CCTV. She lived in Queens, New York with her husband Albert Brown who was an electronics technician who helped her with her invention. Not much is known about Marie's early life but her parents were both African-Americans from Pennsylvania. She originally trained as a nurse and it was her and her husband's irregular work hours that gave her the idea for her invention.

As Marie was often on her own at night and the neighbourhood she lived in had a high crime rate, she felt she needed to find a way to make herself feel safer in the home. Her first invention consisted of a series of peepholes, a sliding camera, TV monitors and microphones. The cameras moved from peephole to peephole and displayed images on the TV screens. The patent for her invention was granted in 1969 and it became the basis for future home security systems that make millions of people all over the world feel safer in their homes.
