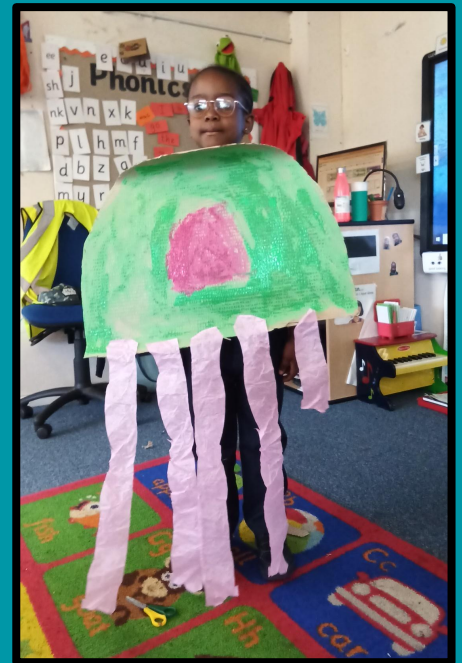


# *Inside the Classroom*

# *Creative learning in Curious Class*

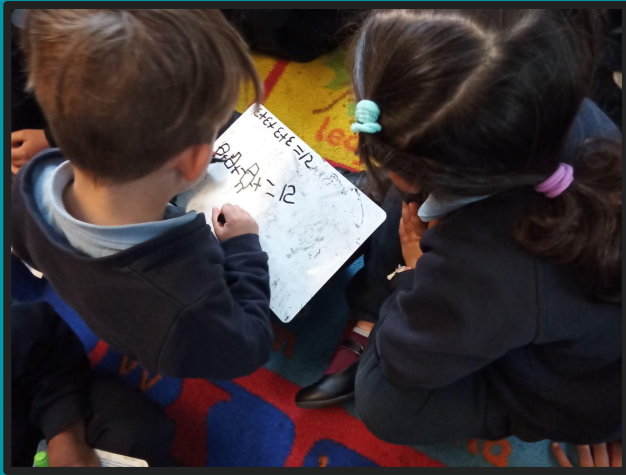


We have deep dived into our new theme and are enjoying making our own under the sea costumes! Can you see what we have become?

# Maths in Curious Class



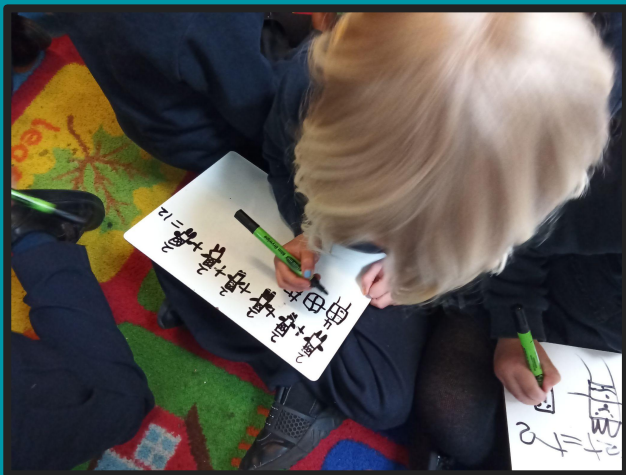
In Maths we have been learning about addition. We have been learning about number bonds, for example how many ways can you make 5?
