

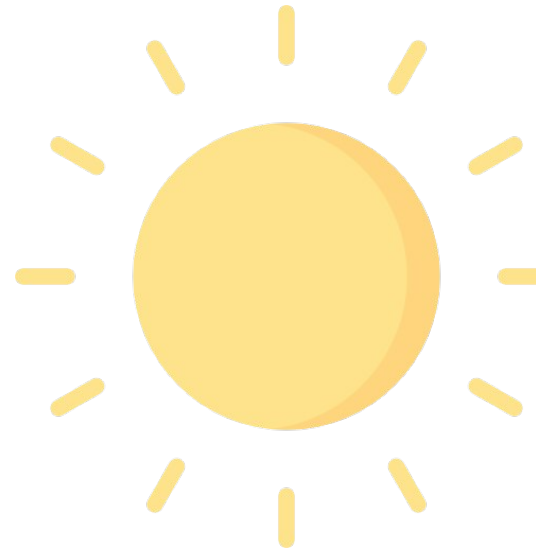

JD Eco-Code

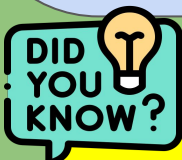
1. Recycle Reuse and Reduce

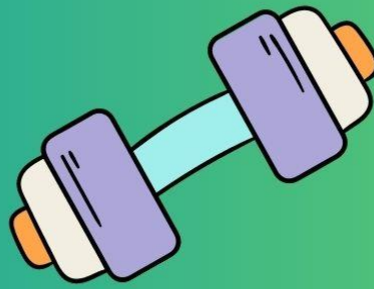


We still need your boots!

You can replace foil and cling film with beeswax wraps. They are reusable, prettier and better for the environment.

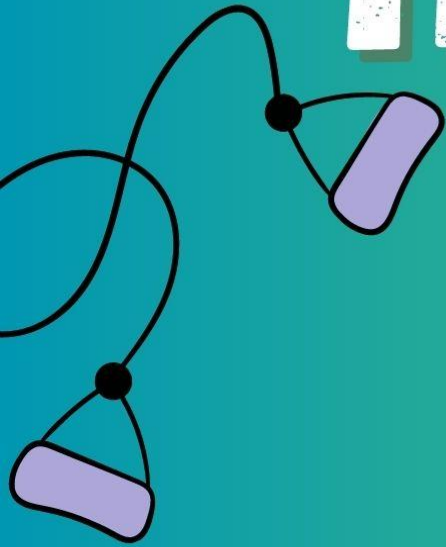
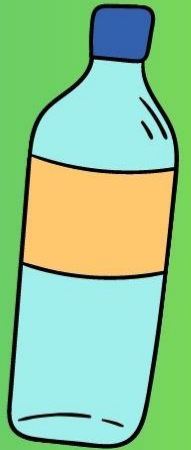

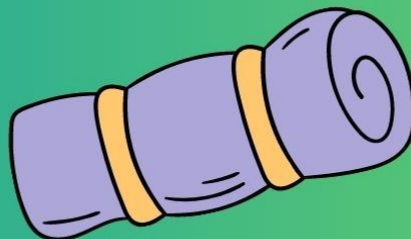
